

A Student Local Fee Committee (Committee) has been established in accordance with Florida Statute 1009.24; the Committee is recommending student fee increases effective Fall Term 2010:

- Activity & Service (A&S) – an increase in the current fee from \$9.96 to \$10.47 per credit hour; estimated annual revenue \$10,900,003.
- Athletics – an increase in the current fee from \$6.77 to \$7.09 per credit hour, estimated annual revenue \$7,381,186.
- Health/Counseling – an increase in the current fee from \$8.81 to \$9.25, estimated annual revenue \$9,629,898.

Additionally, the Committee is recommending a health fee of \$2 per credit hour for the purpose of paying down the indebtedness of the new Wellness Center. This increase is allowable per Chapter 2009-60 of the Laws of Florida, which states “...Florida State University is authorized to exceed the 5 percent cap on annual increases to the aggregate sum of activity and service, health and athletic fees... for the purpose of increasing the health fee. Revenue generated... shall be used to construct a health service center.”

Annual revenue estimates were derived using projected 2010-2011 credit hours of 1,041,070.

A public hearing will be conducted by the Committee to receive comments and suggestions from the student body on the specific recommendations to be announced at the hearing. The hearing will be held from 11:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. Monday, November 16, 2009 in room 214 Student Services Building.
