413.7 Spring Awards

One week before the annual Presidential Inauguration, every spring semester the Student Senate shall vote on the following four awards. These awards shall be presented during the Presidential Inauguration ceremony to the Senator receiving the most votes for each award.

- A. Mattie Durham Senator of the Year - The Senator that best served students, Student Senate and the larger university community.
- B. Senate Ethics Award - The Senator who carried out their duties with the highest sense of personal ethics and honor.
- C. New Senator of the Year - The best Senator who is serving their first term in Senate (not necessarily a Freshman).
- D. Chair of the Year - The best Chair of the Resource for Travel Allocation Committee (RTAC) Programming Allocation Committee (PAC) and Standing Committee Chairs (other than Rules and Calendar, Central Reserves and Sweepings).
