### Chapter 700   Restrictions on Altering the Election Code

~~The Election Code, which is in force three (3) weeks prior to an election, shall be the election code used for that election, regardless of changes made in the interim.~~

Once the date for an election has been determined, according to 705.4 and 706.5, the election code used for that election cannot be changed. The Election Code will be enforced three weeks prior to an election.

207.1      Definitions

The following definitions shall be fully applicable for the purpose of this act.

- A.      “New Senator” shall be defined as any member of the Student Senate who has served less than one semester as a student senator.
- B.      “Senior Senator” shall be defined as any member of the Student Senator who has served at least one year as a student senator.
- C.      “Mentor” shall be defined as a senior senator who will directly educate and assist an assigned freshman senator about The Student Government Association and especially the Student Senate.

207.1 207.2      The purpose of this legislation is to ensure that all officials of the Florida State University Student Government Association have received adequate training in the areas of fiscal and ethical responsibility in the allocation and expenditure of state funds collected through the Activity and Service Fee.

207.2 207.3      All SGA officials holding a major office, as well as members of the Congress of Graduate Students, are required to conform to the provisions of this Statute.

207.3 207.4      The Student Body President, Student Senate President, Chief Justice of the Student Supreme Court, Chair of the Union Board, Chair of the Campus Recreation Board, Senior Class Council President, Speaker of the Congress of Graduate Students, and the Directors of all Executive Agencies, Bureaus and Affiliated Projects, as well as all Funding Board Chairs, shall conduct an appropriate training program suitable to the needs of the members of their respective organizations within four (4) weeks of ~~the fall SGA elections~~ their election or confirmation by the Student Senate in which the members of their respective organizations have been elected. The content of such training programs shall be at the discretion of the officers listed in the beginning of this section and shall be directed at teaching new members about the SGA Constitution and Statutes, and all pertinent procedures encountered during the operation of their respective organizations.

207.4 207.5      New Senator Orientation



- A. New Senator Orientation shall serve as a means to bring about a more efficient transition into Student Senate for new senators.
- A. B. The Student Senate President, in conjunction with Student Senate President Pro Tempore, ~~or designated proxies,~~ shall be required to conduct New Senator Orientation on the Wednesday and Thursday prior to the Fall and Spring Student Government Inaugurations. In the case of a contested election, or special circumstances, New Senator Orientation may be moved to the week after the Fall and Spring Inaugurations. ~~The seminar will be a training session to cover the Student Body Constitution and Statutes, the Senate Rules of Procedure, Robert Rules of Order, as well as any applicable parliamentary procedures.~~ New Senator Orientation shall consist of teaching new senators how to compose and submit a bill for first reading, compose and submit a resolution for first reading, properly follow Robert's Rules of Order during a Senate meeting, and properly follow Student Senate Rules of Procedure. In addition, new senators shall have a basic understanding of the Student Body Constitution, Student Body Statutes, and SGA Financial Manual.
- C. At New Senator Orientation, the new senators shall take part in a mock Senate meeting in which the Student Senate President, in conjunction with the Student Senate President Pro Tempore, shall teach the new senators all relevant information about the procedure of a Senate meeting.
- B. D. New Senators shall be required to successfully complete New Senator Orientation and attend a scheduled meeting with the Senate President ~~and/or President Pro Tempore~~ in which the new senator's committee appointment shall be discussed in addition to any relevant questions the freshman senator might have. Successful completion of New Senator Orientation shall be determined by the Senate President and/or Senate President Pro Tempore senator who conducts it.
- G. E. It is the responsibility of the current or outgoing Student Senate President to conduct New Senator Orientation.
1. The Senate President has the option of delegating the responsibility of conducting New Senator Orientation to the Student Senate Pro Tempore Rules and Calendar Committee ~~or a proxy of their choice.~~

- A. ~~Following the Senate Retreat or informational seminar~~ New Senator Orientation, it shall be the responsibility of the Senate Pro Tempore to assign a Senior Senator (~~one who has been in office for more than one term~~) to an incoming a New Senator as a mentor. ~~Like procedures shall be followed for forwarded Senators. The Senate Pro Tempore shall assign a mentor to new senators who are forwarded for confirmation, and subsequently confirmed by the Student Senate.~~ The purpose of ~~such the~~ mentoring program shall be to help new senators learn the appropriate techniques for writing legislation, master the rules and procedures that govern the Student Senate, and understand the responsibilities and duties of being a senator. ~~If a significant problem (such as differences in campus party ideology) arises between a mentor and mentee, either Senator may petition the Senate Pro Tempore for reassignment. Any new senator or mentor may petition the Senate Pro Tempore for reassignment. It shall be up to the discretion of the Senate Pro Tempore whether or not to grant reassignment.~~
- B. A voluntary survey to ascertain the efficiency of the program will be conducted by the Senate Pro Tempore at the last meeting of each Senate term.
