Resolution 1

Sponsored by: Senator Alvarez

Whereas: The Constitution of the Student Body Section 3 States "The mission of the Student Government Association (SGA), is to provide FSU students with representation, services and advocacy within the university structure." and

Whereas: The Constitution of the Student Body Section 4 States: "All students shall be entitled to vote in the Student Body elections" and

Whereas: The Constitution of the Student Body Section 5.F States: "The purpose of this organization shall be: To provide an official voice through which the opinions of the student body may be expressed" and

Whereas: The Constitution of the Student Body Section 5.H States: "The purpose of this organization shall be: To inform all students of SGA activities and encourage participation in them" and

Whereas: The Student Government Agency did not advertise for the Declaration of Candidacies or Registration of Parties for the Fall 70th Student Senate, Fall 26th Congress of Graduate Students, or Campus Recreation Board elections, and

Whereas: Of the 48 available Student Senate seats of the Fall 2017 Election, only 17 seats were Declared for, only one seat was contested, and any student not eligible to vote for an "Undergraduate" seat could not vote, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEVENTIETH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The Student Government Association must set aside resources for advocacy for Florida State University Students to Declare Candidacy, campaign, and run for elected positions in the Student Government Association, alongside efforts by the Senate to assist the Executive Branch in appointing Deputies to the office of the Supervisor of Elections, and
