WHEREAS: Goal III of The Florida State University's Strategic Plan claims that "by valuing, celebrating and leveraging the differences and similarities within our community, we create a fertile environment...", and

WHEREAS: Section 3 of Article I of the Student Body Constitution claims that "the Student Government Association provides quality leadership for, and accountability to its constituency by recognizing that strength arises from diversity engagement and dialogue," and

WHEREAS: Subsection D of Section 5 of Article I of the Student Body Constitution claims that a duty of the Student Government Association is "to receive complaints from students, investigate the problems of students and participate in academic policy making decisions concerning students", therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEVENTIETH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The Golden Tribe Lecture Series Committee should better strive to invite more diverse speakers who will better foster a sense of inclusivity on campus.
