WHEREAS: Bill 33 revises statutes to make Student Affairs more involved in the Golden Tribe Lecture Series, and

WHEREAS Senate Rules of Procedure do not reflect this change, and

WHEREAS When tasking a committee with new responsibilities, the Senate Rules of Procedure should be updated, and

WHEREAS Senate Rules of Procedure 15.3 states "Any amendment to these rules shall be presented to the Senate in the form of a resolution," and

WHEREAS Any permanent amendment of the rules requires a two thirds (2/3) vote of the Senate, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEVENTIETH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The following rules be amended as follows:

6.5 The Senate Student Life and Academic Affairs Committee shall:

- a. Review issues pertaining to the student body in order to benefit student life on campus and inform the Senate as to any pertinent action or project.
- b. Analyze the academic experience of the student body in order to focus on solving issues regarding all areas of academics on campus and inform the Senate as to any pertinent action.
- c. Conduct forums for students to express their concerns. The committee is encouraged to work with the Executive Branch.
- d. Shall review the Senate Projects Account requests and (the Golden Tribe Lecture Series Fundable Speakers List) in order to enrich the student experience.
- e. The Committee shall work with the Senate President in order to ensure all designated campus entities have Senate liaisons. The Committee will compile liaison reports in order to inform the Senate as to any pertinent action.
- f. Conduct other hearings, investigations, and undertake such other business as the Senate shall determine.
