

A. Adoption

1. There shall be a joint initiative of the Executive Branch, Legislative Branch, and Union Productions called the Golden Tribe Lecture Series.

B. Purpose

1. The purpose of this act is to provide the student body with a series of speakers sponsored by the Student Government Association. The Golden Tribe Lecture Series will be an academically focused speaker series that attempts to connect students to outstanding individuals who are either experts in their field or working at the forefront of a relevant political or social issue. The mission of the series is to engage students in issues and dialogue that will positively benefit their overall academic, scholastic, or humanitarian experience.

C. Definitions

1. "late notice cancellation" – A cancellation by a speaker made at such a time as the committee cannot find a replacement speaker from the Fundable Speakers List.

612.2 Composition

- A. The Golden Tribe Lecture Series Committee, herby to be referred to for the purposes of this statue as "The committee", shall consist of the following:
 - 1. The Committee shall consist of:
 - a. Director of the Center for Global Engagement or designee
 - b. Two (2) faculty-at-large members appointed by the Faculty Senate
 - c. Student Body President or designee
 - d. Student Senate President or designee
 - e. Four (4) Students-at-large members appointed by the Student Body President and approved by the Senate.
 - f. One (1) Student Senator, appointed by the Senate President
 - g. Union Production Lectures Director
 - h. Union Productions Public Relations and Marketing Director
 - Union Productions Programming Director
- B. Committee appointments under section 612.2 (A-1) subsections e, and f shall last for (1) year; thereafter reappointment shall be conducted as per statutes.

- Selection of Faculty-at-Large Members and Student-at-Large Members
 - A. The Student Government Association Student Body President shall appoint four students-at-large to serve as members on the committee, these students shall be from different colleges or division on campus.
 - 1. The Student Body President must forward candidates to the Student Senate by the end of January of every year. In the case that this is not done, all applicants will be sent to the Senate for appointment at the next regularly schedules session.
 - B, The Faculty Senate shall appoint two Faculty-at-large members through the internal procedures of the Faculty Senate to serve as members on the committee. Both shall be different colleges or divisions of campus.
- The Chair shall be the Union Productions Lectures Chair, and the Vice Chair shall be elected by The Golden Tribe Committee. The Vice Chair can be any student on the committee.
 - A. Duties of the Chair
 - 1. Call and preside over all meetings and general business of the committee.
 - 2. Ensure compliance of Title VIII of Student Body Statutes.
 - 3. Prepare, and submit to the Student Senate, a proposed budget for each fiscal year.
 - 4. Prepare and submit to the Student Life and Academic Affairs Committee at least yearly, but no more than once a semester, a list of names of potential speakers the golden tribe lecture series committee wishes to have placed on the Fundable Speakers List
 - 5. Submit any documents showing proof of speaker cancellation to the Student Life and Academic Affairs committee as per 612.5 (L).
 - 6. Create and issue the survey created under section 612.5 (B).
 - B. Duties of the Vice Chair
 - 1. Perform the duties of the Chair in their absence.
 - Maintain accurate minutes and records of the committee meetings.
 - 3. Other duties delegated by the Chair.
 - 4. Give monthly updates to Senate regarding the Golden Tribe Lecture Series Committee.

612.5 Powers and Duties

A. The committee is primarily responsible for organizing and administering a semesterly or yearly Golden Tribe Lecture Series.

- 1. The committee shall also be responsible for organizing any speaker scheduled for Martin Luther King Jr. week that is sponsored by the Student Government Association.
- 2. The committee shall hold meetings on a monthly basis.
- B. The Committee <u>Chair</u> shall <u>create and issue a survey via the SGA website to send out to the student body for speaker suggestions. The committee shall further research the adequate suggested speakers <u>and ensure that they</u> will provide educational content for the student body.</u>
- C. The Committee shall select speakers ensure selected speakers will discuss topics pertinent to the Florida State University student body. The Committee shall make certain that speakers of diverse political perspectives are given equal weight in the selection of process.
- D. The Committee shall provide host no less than two (2) speakers per year.
 - 1. This clause does not apply for any speaker scheduled for Martin Luther King Jr. week that is sponsored by the Student Government Association.
- E. The Committee shall be responsible for adequate advertisement of speakers no less than one week prior to the event. The advertisement shall consist of the time, date, location, name of speaker, and topic to be discussed.
- F. The Committee shall submit reports to the Student Senate once per semester discussing progress and actions taken.
- G. The Committee shall adopt its own rules of procedure for its organization, administration, and procedures, provided none of those rules of procedure conflict with any portion of the Student Body Statutes.
 - 1. The committee shall be able to appoint any ex-officio non-voting members as desired through a majority vote of the committee.
- H. The Committee shall exercise sole authority over the expenditure of funds allocated for all or part of any Golden Tribe Lecture Series so long as such expenditures do not violate, or conflict with any parts of the Student Body Statutes.
- I. The Committee will organize, promote, and fund any only individual speakers, lecturers, or events the committee deems worthwhile, that utilize speakers from the Fundable Speakers List created under section (K), providing the individual, lecture, or event is not in conflict with any other provision of law.
- J. The committee chair, along with the entire Golden Tribe Committee will create a list containing all the names of speakers they may ever want to sponsor as being apart of the Golden Tribe Lecture Series. The Golden Tribe lecture series chair will submit a list to the Student Life and Academic Affairs committee within a week of the first Senate session of the spring semester and can upon its discretion submit one more list for approval within a week of the first first Senate session of Fall semester. The Student Life and Academic Affairs committee will vote to forward or reject each named speaker on that list. Should the Student Life and Academic Affairs committee fail to forward any speakers, the Golden Tribe Lecture committee shall provide them with a

- list of new speakers. The Student Life and Academic Affairs committee chair shall introduce a consent resolution containing the names of all speakers the committee approved to the Senate for their approval. Senate as a whole cannot add additional names without referring the list back to Student Life and Academic Affairs Committee. Should the consent resolution pass in the Senate the speakers listed shall be labeled approved for funding for the purposes of section (K). Speakers rejected by the senate shall not be resubmitted by the Golden Tribe Lecture committee.
- K. The committee shall maintain a list of all speakers approved for funding. The list shall be entitled "The Golden Tribe Lecture Series Fundable Speakers List" and shall only include speakers that were labeled approved for funding via 612.5(J). The Golden Tribe lecture committee shall select speakers for the Golden Tribe Lecture Series from this list.
- L. No funds allocated for all or part of any Golden Tribe Lecture Series may be expended to organize, promote, or fund any Speaker(s), that are not listed on The Golden Tribe Lecture Series Fundable Speakers List. The only exceptions to this is are:
 - 1. If a late notice cancellation by a speaker leaves the committee without the time to invite another speaker from the approved speaker list, the committee can by a 2/3 vote approve a onetime allocation of funds to book a replacement speaker even if that speaker is not on the approved speaker list. Documented proof of cancellation should be submitted to the Student Life and Academic Affairs committee chair within a week of an enactment of this clause by the Lecture Committee.
 - 2. If a speaker reaches out to the committee wishing to speak, and is not on the approved for funding list, and is unable to be added to the list in the manner specified in Statutes due to scheduling constraints, and the committee does not have any speakers already on the approved for funding list wanting to speak or scheduled to speak, then the committee can send an emergency request to the Office of the Senate President for permission to host said speaker only once. The Senate President should consult with the Student Life and Academic Affairs Committee before making their decision. A formal writeup should be presented to the Senate by the Golden tribe committee chair outlining the details behind the enactment of this clause within a week of its enactment.
- M. The Golden Tribe Lecture Series account shall not be swept at the end of the fiscal year.
- No part of these statutes should be construed as meaning that a speaker who is not listed on The Golden Tribe Lecture Series Fundable Speakers List is unable to speak at Florida State. These statutes only make it so that in order for SGA funding allocated to the Golden Tribe Lecture series to be used, the speaker must be approved by the Senate through the processes listed in this chapter. These statutes in no way bar RSO's or any other organizations from using their own funding to host a speaker.O. The SGA Senate through the

- passage of a resolution may remove speakers from the Golden Tribe Lecture Series Approved Speakers List.
- P. All individual(s), lecture(s), or event(s) that are being actively organized, promoted, or funded as of 2/28/2018 will be considered approved speakers.

A. The Executive Projects Account, and the Student Government Association Golden Tribe Lecture Series Account may use the lump sum of funds in the expense account for any purpose. The Student Government Association Golden Tribe Lecture Series may use the lump sum of funds in the expense account for use in carrying out its prescribe purpose in chapter 612 of the Student Body Statutes, making sure that all uses align with all of Student Body Statutes.
