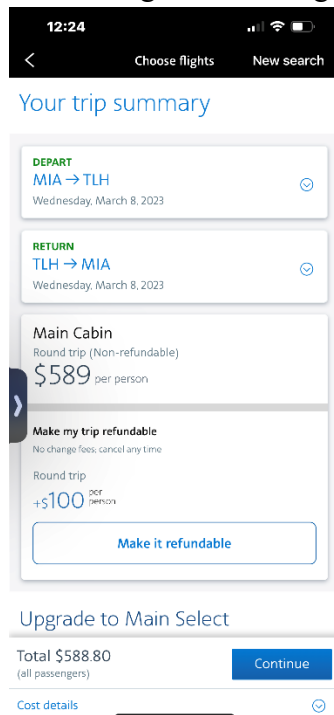
# Meeting Minutes
