  - We will be using the field, rock wall, and pavilion at the Rez to host our Medical Survival Fitness event. Attendees will be assigned to teams, and we will have multiple stations for them to cycle through. Stations will include and obstacle course, a wilderness first aid training (with splints, tourniquets, and other first aid demonstration), a litter/carry training station, a high intensity vital sign reading station, rock climbing for medical evacuation, and a hands-on cricothyrotomy workshop. After each team has been to all the stations, they will participate in a race to demonstrate the skills they learned.
