


- What are the funds for?
 - "We will be gathering together to install the first of the 51 Tom Project AEDs at The Globe. This symbolic event will give us a chance to explain to the community (and Tom's family) about accomplishments and resources provided by this student health initiative. There will be free food, program guides, CPR and AED training signups, ECG heart screens for 300 people and program guides describing the initiative. These funds will allow us to advertise the event, bind and put together program guides, and supply attendees with additional food"
- What is the Publix purchase?
 - "While Proof Brewing Company will be providing donated food, this may not accommodate the event. This PO will supplement the catering with Publix sandwiches, drink cups, silverware, ice, protein bars, etc. Since this is an unprecedented event and the bulk of our advertising efforts have not commenced, this PO will hopefully give us the flexibility to buy more food if crowds are higher than anticipated."
