

Dr. Standridge initially joined TMH Physician Partners at their Wakulla office, a certified Rural Health Center, and after 6 years took over as the Medical Director of the Southwood Physician Partners location in Tallahassee. Throughout his career he served as a mentor for medical students and was awarded the Mission Model Award by the Florida State College of Medicine Tallahassee campus in 2017. Having long considered a career in academics he joined the faculty at the TMH Family Medicine Residency in 2022. He is excited to train the next generation of Family Physicians and to equip them to be leaders in their communities.
