## Questions:

- What are the funds for?
- The goal of this event is to expose children to medical professionals and teach them about what we do.
Medical students will come to the childcare center for a 1-hour time slot and lead activities with 5 different classrooms of children. The children range from 2 to 4.5 years old. The activities will be two different arts \& crafts and a teddy bear physical exam. We will be doing "X is for X-Ray" for the 8 toddlers, "Doctor Bag" for the 20 tweeners, and the teddy bear physical exam for the 24 pre-schoolers (these children will be performing a "physical exam" on their own teddy bear). Medical students will also be, safely, showing the children real medical equipment and teaching them about how they work and what we do with them.

Our intention is to show these children that doctors/nurses/medical staff are nice and here to help you, and also to help alleviate some of their fears when they go to the doctor's office. In other words, if they see our stethoscopes in person and are able to hold and manipulate them on their own, then they might not be so scared of the stethoscope when their own pediatrician goes to listen to their heart and lungs. It is *very* important that every child gets their own teddy bear for this event, so that real medical equipment is used on teddy bears *only* and NOT on peers/other children/other medical students. We feel that it is crucial for these children to gain exposure to real medical equipment for education purposes, but we want to make sure this is done in a safe manner. For example, we want to show how to use a stethoscope on a teddy bear and not a human. This is why we ask for 56 total teddy bears in the Excel sheet.
