#### Questions:

- What are the funds for?
  - We will be using the field, rock wall, and pavilion at the Rez to host our Medical Survival Fitness event. Attendees will arrive, check in to receive their name-tags and team assignments, and be served lunch before beginning the event activities. They will then disperse to the multiple stations they will be cycling through. Stations will include and obstacle course, a wilderness first aid training (with splints, tourniquets, and other first aid demonstration), a litter/carry training station, a high intensity vital sign reading & emergency hydration station, rock climbing for medical evacuation, and a hands-on cricothyrotomy workshop. After each team has been to all the stations, they will participate in a race to demonstrate the skills they learned.

All supplies will be used by participants throughout the training stations and race. Each participant will have their own "nick fixer" survival kit with tools and an emergency blanket needed to complete various challenges. Each team will have backpacks filled with other necessary supplies (trauma shears, ace wraps, rolled gauze, water bottles & hydration packets). The backpacks will be weighted for the rock wall station so that participants can practice patient management while climbing. Bottles will be used at the emergency hydration station along with hydration packets as part of an exposure training session. During the final race, participants will use these tools to complete their final challenge.
