  - Dr. Jonathan P. Salud (FSUCOM alumnus, M.D. '15) is a board-certified internist at the University of Washington Medical Center (UWMC) in Seattle, Washington. He is a core faculty for the Internal Medicine Residency Program at Elson S. Floyd College of Medicine. He will be sharing his experience as a hospitalist taking care of hospitalized COVID-19 patients during the pandemic, both in-patient and outpatient settings. He planned to share the impact the pandemic has on the healthcare team overall.
  - Note: Approved for a total of **\$800.00**; RSO was advised to reduce original shirt request amount as shirts are not part of the budget for the year.
    - MSC is accommodating shirts for RSOs that were not able to fulfill a purchase request for shirts in the past financial year.
  - Note: RSO was advised to return with new quote and design, to be submitted with this request.

- What are the funds for?
  - To fulfill our mission of educating students about exercise and nutrition, we will be hosting a beginners workout class lead by a fitness instructor from Sweat Therapy Fitness. Last time, we requested \$111 for food, and with the great turnout, we went through that food very quickly. So we would like to request more funds to provide more food. The event will be outside, and everyone will be socially distanced.
  - Note: Approved for a total of **\$242.66**:
    - \$75.00 for contractual services for Sweat Therapy Fitness Instructor; vendor has been used in the past by the RSO
    - \$4.02 for 6lbs of bananas, \$12.82 for 2 boxes of 6-pk Clif bars (Chocolate Chip/PB Crunch), \$13.32 for 12 Clif bars (Dark Chocolate Mocha), \$13.32 for 12 Clif bars (PB), \$13.32 for 12 Clif bars (Chocolate Chip), \$13.32 for 12 Clif Bars (Vanilla Almond Latte), \$87.67 for 11 packs of 4ct Celsius Live Fit Supplement Drinks, \$9.87 for 3lbs of Honeycrisp apples.
