- Resolution 2- Sponsored by Sojos- To push for the mandatory 2nd health authorization forms to be included in new student packets

- Resolution 2- Sponsored by Sojos
 - 5 minutes for opening

 - Selva asks about forms sent to incoming students; no hold is put on account without 2nd form.
 - Motion to move into roundtable made by Levin, seconded by Jacobsen
 - Jacobsen asks about presentation for minutes
 - Motion for non-committee member to speak made by Levin, seconded by Selva
 - Villacorta brings up that this is not the issue and both forms are available at orientation and the website; hold should be put on account. Has issues with the resolution because senate micromanage other organizations. Villacorta says that he talked to Compliance.
 - Maymon asks if the problem is that students under 18 are not sent this form
 - Sojos says you have to ask for this form, it is not available to public.
 - Villacorta asks if this isn't passed, will she still ask.
 - The Health and Wellness center may come to senate in support
 - Warren asks who Villacorta talked to



- The Director of compliance is who was talked to
- Sojos say that he talked to director of Health and Wellness, and says if she is willing it is necessary
- Villacorta talked on the phone with the gentleman
- Maymon how she heard of the resolution

- **Bill 16-** Sponsored by Porter
 - Porter opens
 - Pen has ACE info on it
 - Closing ends with 3 minutes and 42 seconds
 - Motion to move into roundtable by Levin, seconded by Ferguson
 - Levin speaks in Support
 - Warren asks how much is in Senate Projects
 - Maymon moves to call question, Levin seconds
 - Porter closes with 3 minutes and 18 seconds

- **Resolution 11-** Sponsored by Villacorta
 - Villacorta opens
 - Working with Environment Florida to encourage university to become more sustainable, yields rest of opening to Willow
 - Environment Florida collects petitions to gain support from student body to show passion for 100% renewable energy.
 - Yields with 3 minutes and 8 seconds
 - No technical and nondebatable questions
 - Motion to move into roundtable by Levin, and seconded by Maymon
 - Levin asks about the word Climate Change
 - MacMillan asks how that would happen
 - Villacorta says that the city has decided to do it, the general intent is to leave it open for discussion about how this would be done.
 - Maymon says he understands the point, but he doesn't see why we would sugar coat the climate change wording
 - Levin suggests negative environmental points
 - Jacobsen suggests cutting out first whereas
 - Villacorta says he wouldn't find it friendly because it is science
 - MacMillan says he doesn't think many senators wouldn't vote against it
 - Maymon adds that shortchanging resolution isn't for the senate
 - Jacobsen adds that we represent diverse group of people and doesn't feel comfortable saying everyone believes the same thing
 - Villacorta says that he has 3,000 signatures for support
 - Warren wants clarification on FSU's green plan
 - Villacorta says that the plan changes often and that the resolution wouldn't conflict
 - Ferguson says that eliminating the first whereas would make sense
 - Maymon says he understands but says point of SLAA is to make statement.
 - Jacobsen **moves to amend** to strike out the first whereas, Ferguson seconds, sponsor doesn't find it friendly
 - Jacobsen has 3 minutes for opening



- Motion to go into roundtable by Selva, Maymon seconds
- Levin says that the majority of student body isn't addressed in this resolution because we don't know the facts
- Maymon asks what the negative setback is
- Selva says there is no need for debate and statement is made
- Ferguson says there shouldn't be politically charged comments
- Fink asks if this has been passed before, answer is no
- Villacorta says that more people than in some elections support this and that this is appropriate
- Maymon says that we shouldn't keep just striking our words in SLAA
- Warren says that we have to look at bigger picture
- Maymon says that many people don't participate and that the 3000 petitions signed is significant
- Villacorta states that he understands that most people don't follow SGA but considering this is a big sample size and we can't claim to represent people and turn down their voices
- Maymon asks about how SLAA works and where amendment will go
- He wants to do work in committee and debate it on senate floor
- Levin moves to call the question for amendment, MacMillan seconds
- Jacobsen closes, states that her studies have shown that the colleges are important, and they don't have it on their papers with signatures.

AMMENDMENT YAY: 6 (Warren, Levin, Ferguson, Selva, Jacobsen, MacMillan) NAY: 1 (Maymon) ABS: 1 (Fink)

- Motion to let non senator to speak made by Levin, seconded by Warren
- Porter says he would suggest voting against resolution and that it doesn't accomplish anything
- Willow responds by saying she thinks its ok to leave it blank because it leaves open many options and abilities. Steps wouldn't be beneficial
- MacMillan asks if the plan has an end goal
- Willows gives the dates
- MacMillon asks what the plans is called
- Villacorta says it's the strategic plan open on website
- Warren asks if the dates match up
- Villacorta says the plan doesn't have concrete dates
- Motion to call question by Macmillan, seconded by Ferguson, no objections
- Closing by Villacorta
- Sponsored yields 2 minutes and 18 seconds
