Bill 90	Sponsored by Senator Salazar (P) Budget reallocation within the HLSU budget to accommodate for misallocations when first dividing up the budget. Allocating \$1750 from HLSU contract to HLSU food and expenses in the form of \$1250 to HLSU food and \$500 to HLSU expenses.
Bill 91	Sponsored by Senator White (P) To change PAC and RTAC membership statues to expand participation on the funding boards.
Bill 92	Sponsored by Senator Brewer (P) Arellano, Birdsong, Brown, Dennig, Gummerman, McEntyre, Mendez, Newsome, Sparling, Syska, Walerio (Co) This Bill would convert the Catholic Student Union ("CSU") from a Registered Student Organization to an Agency. This would make CSU the eighth esteemed identity-based Agency at FSU.
