- Questioning/Notes
  - Medical Brigades is an international nonprofit organization with over 200 chapters around the world
  - FSU will be doing two brigades since there is so much interest for one in Panama
  - Almost all the volunteers are FSU students, with related majors
  - The Greece brigade flight price has decreased
  - Goldstein: Can you clarify the fundraising deadline?
    - Rep: January 3<sup>rd</sup> was more of a deadline for letting us know who is going on the trip.
  - Goldstein: If you were not to receive full funding, how would you pay for it? Would each volunteer be paying?
    - Rep: Each volunteer pays for the flight, and they have been doing their own fundraising efforts.
  - Goldstein: What is the total amount of fundraising?
    - Rep: I do not off the top of my head but I can send it after the meeting. Probably around \$500 to \$800.
  - Bevis: You're only asking for funding for FSU students, correct?
    - Rep: Yes.
  - Bevis: Can you clarify the lodging price?
    - Rep: Our lodging is paid for through our donation goal.
  - Goldstein: If we funded any of this, would that go towards the donation goal?
    - Rep: We paid for everything altogether. Whatever is funded from you guys, would go toward reducing the prices.
  - Gracia: The total funding you requested was for 58 people, not 64?
    - Rep: Two people actually left, so now it's 62. There are four independent volunteers.
  - Gracia: The \$2239 that you're asking for, is that for the entire group or is that an individual price?
    - Rep: That's the individual price for each volunteer.
  - Goldstein: Is there anything in particular that you would prefer we funded?
    - Rep: Whatever you guys fund, I'm going to distribute evenly among the volunteers.

- **Deliberations:**
  - Goldstein: That all adds up really quick. It would end up around \$4350.
  - Bevis: I agree, and I don't know if we have the money to do that today.

  - Questioning/Notes
    - This is a three-day competition between southern engineering schools
    - We plan to do better than just the top 5 out of 19 schools this year
    - It allows students to build technical skills, and there are many companies present for judging
    - We had a lot more people participate when we hosted a few years ago
    - Goldstein: It says you're requesting for 36 registration fees but that 46 are coming, can you explain that difference?
      - Rep: I submitted it last semester, but the person in charge said that they didn't have money left and that we should reapply this semester. Later on that week, we had six more students say they wanted to attend.
    - Goldstein: I know this is a joint club, so is this just going to be for FSU students?
      - Rep: There are three FAMU students.
    - Bevis: Are those part of the people you're seeking funding for? Because if you are, I don't think we can provide funding for them.
      - Rep: Yes, just for the 43 FSU students.
    - Bevis: Can you walk us through some of the updated costs since what you last gave us?
      - Rep: We needed to add two hotel rooms, and the price of those was \$1140.75, as well as six more registrations at \$510. So taking

away the FAMU students would be \$255 added for the registration.

- Goldstein: For those hotel rooms, are you also including the rooms the FAMU students are staying in?
  - Rep: Yes.
- Bevis: Can you walk me through the numbers I need to change on the line item?
  - Rep: The total would be \$9029.18. The registration would be \$3655. Lodging would be \$6274.18.
- Bevis: How much would your hotel room cost per night?
  - Rep: It was \$159 plus a \$10 destination fee, so \$169.
- Goldstein: What types of fundraising have y'all been able to do yourselves?
  - Rep: We get speakers to sponsor our chapters. Companies reach out to us and come to our general body meetings.
- Goldstein: Do you require SGA funding right now to make this trip happen?
  - Rep: We do not have the funding to be able to pay for this trip.
- Goldstein: Is this the cheapest hotel you were able to find?
  - Rep: After considering destination fees and overnight parking, the total cost ended up being much higher.
- Goldstein motioned to enter roundtable discussion. Vandermeulen seconded.
- **Deliberations:**
  - Goldstein: What are your thoughts on funding maybe half the registration fees?
  - Bevis: I'd be willing to give them a little bit of registration fees.
  - Goldstein: I'd be willing to pay for a portion of something.
  - Gracia: It would bring us to around \$1700 if we were to pay for half their registration fees.
- Goldstein motioned to fund \$40 per person under registration (\$1720). Gracia seconded.
- Gracia motioned to fund \$0 in lodging. Vandermeulen seconded.

      - Rep: Everyone wanted to do either just the student or both the student and the annual conference.
    - Goldstein: Would it be beneficial if the total \$1820 was funded for just the base registration fee?
      - Rep: Yes, \$165 is obviously a lot of money and a lot of our members can't pay that, especially on top of flights and hotels.
    - Goldstein: You guys got full funding last year?
      - Rep: We did.
    - Goldstein: Was it similar cost?
      - Rep: Yes, it was right around here. But we have more members attending this year.
  - Goldstein motioned to enter roundtable discussion. Vandermeulen seconded.

    - Goldstein: I'm not sure if the \$165 is going to make or break whether or not they go on the trip. It sounds like they could still go on the trip if we funded \$0.
    - Bevis: I agree. Also, I'm for funding them since we do have some money to spare.
    - Goldstein: Do you want to fully fund them or partially fund them?
    - Bevis: Definitely not fully fund. I was thinking somewhere around the \$2000 range.

    - Goldstein: I think we should fund about half of their lodging.

    - Bevis: I was thinking about half of the transportation.
    - Goldstein: I kind of want to fund \$0 because of how much their organization sounds like Greek life, which I know it's not. But I'm fine with funding part of their transportation.

      - Rep: For the lodging, it was going to be three and two.

    - Lansdale: The airfare pricing out of Tallahassee is pretty expensive, so not very easy to put funding toward.
    - Bevis: Anyone have an idea of a range they would like to fund?
    - Goldstein: I don't really want to fund them. Plus, it's only five students, which doesn't seem fair.
    - Lansdale: The other groups did have a lot more people.
    - Goldstein: We also don't have a veterinary program at this school, so I don't know what we're trying to boost.
