- Our mission statement is to inspire all women to remain empowered, excel academically, and aspire to be self-sufficient
- Anyone can attend this trip, even non-members
- Organizations we plan to work with Hands on Atlanta, Hope Atlanta, and Must Ministries Donation Center
- We got in contact with Astro and we are asking for about $\$ 4500$
- We have about $\$ 7500$ saved in our account and we have a fundraiser coming up at the end of this month with Double Good, and a candygram fundraiser
- Vandermeulen: Is the headcount number you just gave us, 34 , still tentative at all or is it final?
- Rep: It's final. We sent a form out and had a meeting.
- Bevis: What are your dates of travel again?
- Rep: We wanted to do March 29-31, which is Friday to Sunday.
- Bevis: What fundraising has your organization done?
- Rep: We've done football concessions for around $\$ 3000$. We did a Double Good last semester which brought in around $\$ 2000$. Other small market fundraisers have brought in hundreds.
- Bevis: If you weren't able to get full funding from us, do you have a plan for affording to attend this trip?
- Rep: I believe that we can because the funding we're mostly looking for is for transportation. We have been in contact with a few hotels and we believe that with the $\$ 85$ per person rate would cover lodging. That doesn't include other expenses that members would spend on food or activities.
- Bevis: If you were in a situation where we were only able to give you half of the money requested, would you all still be able to afford this?
- Rep: Yes, I think so with our saving and our budgeting.
- Mayo: What exactly would the $\$ 85$ per traveler cover?
- Rep: It's just covering for the hotel and lodging. The members would be responsible for food and activities. But our hotels will have free breakfast, so we don't have to come too much out of pocket.
- Motion: Gracia motioned to enter roundtable discussion. Vandermeulen seconded.
- Deliberations:
- Bevis: To give context, they came to us asking for money for a service trip and we heard them last week about their bus. On paper, it had a good presentation but we felt like, when we asked questions, they were giving us different answers and we didn't have all the information we needed.
- Vandermeulen: I do remember some question dodging and how Jonus wasn't able to get very many answers. And I believe this is the third time they've come to us.
- Bevis: Yes, we had given them money for the lodging before. But we couldn't do the same when they asked to fund the bus because it initially wasn't a university-approved vendor. It has to be Astro or Annett.
- Mayo: Looking at the CR, they're asking for $\$ 4401.95$ ?
- Bevis: Right, sorry. I forgot to change this number. Thanks for catching that.
- Gracia: I think we can fully fund honestly. They've come back time and time again for this bus and it seems like they need it.
- Vandermeulen: And I remember last Senate meeting, there were quite a few people being vocal in advocating for organizations, including this one.

- We accept various types of engineers who are interested
- We aim to present internship and job opportunities from professionals
- Tutoring for chemical and biomedical engineer majors is also something we provide
- This conference is at Auburn University, and the most important part is the Chem-E-Car competition
- This is one out of the ten national regional conferences held by AIChE, it's the southern one that aligns with us
- We have a group chat where we sent an interest form and we also advertised it on Instagram to make it available to the entire student body
- The students going are mostly the students involved in the Chem-E-Car competition, and we think they deserve priority
- They're going to represent that FAMU-FSU College of Engineering, so it could be really important for the university as a whole
- We are hoping to get the early-bird registration, which will be $\$ 700$ total
- As for lodging, we have a few quote options and we chose the cheapest one
- Our main option is to drive after looking at the airfare prices
- There are currently no other competitions within these departments
- We are also hoping to eventually go against bigger rivals like UF and Georgia Tech
- If we're not able to receive full funding, we are hoping RTAC will prioritize registration and travel
- Gracia: If we pay this, does that mean the people going on the trip won't be paying for anything else?
- Rep: We were planning on having members pay out-of-pocket for food costs.
- Mayo: Have there been fundraising activities or efforts to help cover some of the cost?
- Rep: We initiated a new fundraising system this past semester that involves getting corporate sponsors. We did try over the STEM career fair to get more contacts with company representatives. There have so far been two potential company sponsors in our packet. With these corporations, it usually takes some time to get funding approved. So we don't know how much we expect to receive.
- Gracia: How many cars are you taking?
- Rep: Two, for seven people.
- Vandermeulen: You said you're staying two nights, right?
- Rep: Yes, two nights. We're planning on traveling and getting there late Thursday night and to do the itinerary on the $15^{\text {th }}$. It's like a 3 to 4 hour drive to Auburn.
- Motion: Vandermeulen motioned to enter roundtable discussion. Gracia seconded.
- Deliberations:
- Vandermeulen: I like how informative it was overall.
- Bevis: Yes, that was definitely one of the better presentations.
- Zeron: Full fund.
- Bevis: You all want to full fund?
- Gracia: I do.
- Vandermeulen: Plus, it is a relatively small amount from what we're used to seeing.
- Zeron: And it's for seven people. I think it's a great cause considering what they want to do.
