ORDER DISMISSING PLAINTIFF'S COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE

This matter came before the Court. The Court has finds as follows:

1. On March 23, 2020, Plaintiff filed this action against Congress of Graduate Students (COGS), for an alleged violation by a COGS representative.
2. Plaintiff demanded relief in the form of vacating a resolution that was in dispute and a re-vote at a forthcoming COGS meeting. This was the only relief sought by Plaintiff.
3. The Court ordered summary judgment motions on March 23, 2020.
