



Activity and Service Fee Sweepings

Proviso Language

Special Instructions

I. General

- A. No A&S fees funded account may pay any stipend, wage, or salary increase to any positions not funded in Sweepings 2017 without express consent of the Student Senate.
- B. In the event of shortfalls or excesses, the Vice President of Student Affairs, the SGA Advisor, the Senate President, and the Student Body President shall meet to review options.
- C. Any funds not spent prior to May 31, 2018 shall be returned to SGA.

II. Campus Recreation

- A. Campus Recreation shall prioritize their expenses to fund projects as follows: Athletic Training Manual Therapy equipment, Fitness personal training equipment, Outdoor Pursuits inflatable stand-up paddleboards, FSU Challenge Portable Escape room, and fitness equipment replacement.
- B. Monies allocated in the OPS category shall be used to compensate for the minimum wage increase.
- C. Monies allocated to Sports Clubs Council shall prioritize their expense to fund: \$20,000 in sports clubs' travel, buoyancy devices or the SCUBA Club, mats for Cheerleading Club, foot stretchers for the Rowing Club, boat covers for the Sailing Club, nets for the Lacrosse Clubs, and \$280 for Frisbees for the Ultimate Frisbee club.

III. Oglesby Union

- A. The Oglesby Union shall prioritize expenses related to transitional space, moving, and student services during Union relocation.
- B. Monies allocated in the OPS category shall be used to compensate for the minimum wage increase.

IV. Executive Projects

- A. Monies allocated to Executive Projects shall be used to support programs and initiatives to support the student body.

V. Student Activities and Organizations

- A. Monies allocated to Inter-Residence Hall Council shall be used for food and t-shirts for the Lord of the Wings event.
- B. Monies allocated to Black Student Union shall be used to support canvas artwork of the BSU House Wall in the new BSU House.
- C. Monies allocated to Student Council for Undergraduate Research and Creativity shall be used for undergraduate student travel grants.
- D. Monies allocated to WVFS 89.7FM shall be used for antenna repair, network switches, and administrative needs.
- E. Monies allocated to Undergraduate Mock Trial Program at FSU shall be used to fund participation in the Mock Trial Tournament in Alabama.
- F. Monies allocated to Class Councils shall be used to fund the President's Toast and Taking Back Suwanee.

VI. Other Departmental Requests

- A. Monies allocated to ACE Learning Studio shall be used for promotional pens as well as snacks and coffee to supply to students during finals in the spring semester. T-shirts, available to all students are suggested to include hours of operation and the SGA logo.

B. Monies allocated to Center for Health Advocacy and Wellness shall be used for food, DJ, and promotional items with the SGA logo for the Spring Wellness Fair.

C. Monies allocated to the University Libraries shall be used for extended hours (24/7) for Strozier and Dirac libraries during spring finals week.

VII. Senate Projects

A. Monies allocated to Senate Projects shall be used to support programs and initiatives to support the student body.

VIII. Congress of Graduate Students

A. Monies allocated to Congress of Graduate Student shall be used to support programs and initiatives to support the student body.
