WHEREAS: The Florida State University 70th Student Senate senators took an oath to defend

the Constitution of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS: The Florida State University 70th Student Senate serves in the best interest of the

student body, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEVENTIETH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The Florida State University Student Senate stands in strong support of the elimination of free speech zones on the college and university campuses in the United States of America.
