Chapter 700 Restrictions on Altering the Election Code

Once the date for an election has been determined, according to 705.4 and 706.5, the election code used for that election cannot be changed. ~~The Election Code will be enforced three (3) weeks prior to an election. Violations to the Election Code will be recognized as violations if they are committed in a time period starting three (3) weeks prior to an election and ending on Monday at 11:59 pm forty-eight (48) hours preceding following the closing of the polls.~~ The Election Code will be enforced in a time period beginning three (3) weeks prior to an election and ending upon the certification of that election. This does not preclude the reporting of violations later enumerated in chapter 711.
