### Chapter 502 Records of the Court

502.1 The Student Supreme Court shall keep records of each case heard. A written opinion of each decision shall be rendered within twenty-one (21) days by a member of the Court and shall be entered immediately in the Florida State University Reporter. This Reporter shall be made available to any interested party and shall constitute the precedents of the Court.

A. Cases being heard on appeal from the Elections Commission awaiting opinion by the Student Supreme Court shall be heard within two weeks of the written appeal.

B. Written Opinions for cases being heard on appeal from the Elections Commission shall be rendered within seventy two (72) hours.

C. Advisory Opinions will be counted as a written opinion for the intents of 502.1.

## Chapter 503 Lower Court System Supreme Court Cases involving Elections

- 503.1 Cases being heard on appeal from the Elections Commission awaiting opinion by the Student Supreme Court shall be heard within 5 business days of the written appeal.
- 503.2 Written Opinions for cases being heard on appeal from the Elections Commission shall be rendered within 5 business days.
