Sponsored by: Senators Jacobsen, Latham, Harmon, Purganan, Durham

Whereas: Florida State University is a Tobacco Free Campus;

Whereas: Rules of Procedure 12.2 states "No use of tobacco products shall be allowed in the Senate Chambers";

Whereas: We feel that this should include the use of JUUL™ products, E- Cigarettes, and any other devices containing nicotine.

Whereas: The act of using JUUL™ products, E- Cigarettes, and any other devices containing nicotine can be distracting during committee meetings and do not promote a productive workplace environment.

Be it resolved by the Seventy-first Student Senate the Florida State University that: Rules of Procedure 12.2 be amended as follows

No Use of tobacco and/ or vaping devices, products including but not limited to JUUL™ products, E- Cigarettes, and any other device containing nicotine, shall not be allowed in the Senate Chambers or within Senate Committee meetings.
