WHEREAS: Article VI, Section 4 of the Student Body Constitution states that opinion questions placed on SGA election ballots “may only be used to access student opinion on issues and shall not be binding on Student Government, nor subject to Court Review before being placed on the ballot”, and

WHEREAS: Chapter 704.5 of the Student Body Statutes states that “All questions of opinions, compulsory referenda, constitutional amendments, and other ballot provisions must be submitted to the Supervisor of Elections from the President of the Student Senate stating the Senate’s approval...”, and

WHEREAS: The stated purposes of the Student Government Association are “to provide an official voice through which the opinions of the student body may be expressed” and “to ensure the greatest participation by students in the immediate governance of and policy development for The Florida State University at all levels”, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEVENTY-FIRST STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

These opinion questions are to be placed on the ballot for the Fall 2019 election:

- a. Do you approve of the work done by the Student Government?
- b. Do you approve of the work done by the Student Senate
- c. Do you approve of the work done by the Student Executive Branch? (President, Vice President, etc.)
- d. Do you approve of the work by SGA Agencies/Bureaus?
(Identity Student Unions, OGA, SCURC, etc.)
