Whereas: The 71st Student Senate Women's Caucus firmly states that inclusivity of all identities are a priority of this university, and

Whereas: The mission of the Student Government Association (SGA) is to provide FSU students with representation, services, and advocacy within the university structure, and

Whereas: As stated in Resolution 74 of the 65th Student Senate, "The Student Body believes in the importance of protecting and providing inclusive facilities for all Florida State students regardless of their gender identity and/or their gender expression", and

Whereas: Individuals with menstrual cycles are disadvantaged by current facilities' lack of sanitary bins in restrooms, and


Whereas: The addition of sanitary bins in all restrooms would foster inclusivity, safety, and comfort for the students and faculty who identify within the transgender community at Florida State,

Be it resolved by the Seventy-first Student Senate the Florida State University that:

1. We encourage facilities have an all gender neutral restroom in all Florida State University buildings.
2. If a Florida State University building does not have an all gender neutral restroom sanitary bins need to be placed in the stalls of all restrooms.
