Men Advocating Responsible Conduct at Florida State University

History: Added by the 59th Senate Bill 75. Amended by the 59th Senate Bill 91. Revised by the 65th Senate Bill 10. Revised by the 66th Senate Bill 72. (changed from Chapter 912 to Chapter 1112)

—1112.1 — Creation, Purpose and Campus Affiliation

A. Creation

There shall be an Affiliated Project of the Student Government Association known as Men Advocating Responsible Conduct, hereinafter referred to as "MARC."

B. Purpose

- 1. MARC shall serve as a forum for students at the Florida State University who seek to educate their peers concerning the importance of appropriate and responsible behavior in all aspects of university life.
- 2. MARC shall provide programming whose purpose is to raise awareness and disseminate information concerning the ideals of responsible conduct, education and behavior to students at FSU.
- 3. MARC may use its relationship with the Victim Advocate Program at FSU to aid students who have found themselves victims of sexual violence.

C. Campus Affiliation

MARC shall be affiliated with the University Health Services of the Florida State University Division of Student Affairs, whose relationship is severable providing that another campus affiliate has been found and approved in accordance with the Student Body Statutes, or the Student Government Association should lawfully end this affiliation.

-1112.2 Board

A. Function

There shall be a campus-wide Board of Students and Staff, hereinafter referred to as the Board, which shall serve as a liaison between the MARC support staff and leadership, the Student Government Association, and campus affiliates. The Board will establish its own criteria for meetings and rules of procedure within the confines of this legislation.

B. Powers and Duties

- 1. The Board shall ensure that all university policies and procedures are followed: the establishment of the Board's meeting criteria and rules of procedure; the approval of annual budget requests to the Student Government Association; the approval of any budget amendment recommendation; and shall approve all new MARC programming.
- 2. The Board shall meet no less than once a month and all meetings must be advertised.

C. Composition

- 1. The Board of MARC shall consist of three (3) student members and two (2) staff members that will be appointed by the Student Body Vice President and the University Health Promotions designee. This selection will take place at the beginning of each April.
- 2. The Student Body Vice President will chair a discussion on who will chair the Board from the three (3) student member that were appointed.

D. Term of Office

- 1. The student positions shall serve a one-year term, however the students may be re-appointed by the Student Body Vice President.
- 2. The faculty/staff members shall serve as long as they hold their appropriate positions in the university or until they shall voluntarily relinquish their position.

E. Minutes

All meetings of the Board shall be recorded by a member of the Board in accordance with its own rules of procedure. These minutes will be provided to all members of the Board within two (2) weeks of the meeting and k
