**Whereas:** The Break the Cycle campaign reports that 43% of dating college women report experiencing some violent and abusive dating behaviors including physical, sexual, tech, verbal or controlling abuse, and

Whereas: The Florida State University Strategic Plan includes ensuring that FSU remains a welcoming and safe campus community, and

Whereas: The kNOw More Student Advisory Board states "Florida State University does not tolerate sexual violence. We continue to actively and aggressively provide institution-wide programs and services to educate our students and university community on responsible conduct, the meaning of consent, how to properly report cases of sexual misconduct, and how to hold individuals accountable for their behavior.", and

**Whereas:** It is our duty as a Senate to promote student wellness and support the initiatives of campus entities such as the Center for Health Advocacy and Wellness and the kNOW More Student Advisory Board,
