Whereas: While the first amendment rights of all students and vendors are protected, no ideology is immune to criticism or denunciation, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Seventy-second Student Senate at Florida State University that: The first amendment rights of all students and organizations be protected and the sale of Nazi paraphernalia be denounced by the Student Senate.
