73rd STUDENT SENATE Senate Resolution

Resolution #: 79

Whereas: The Student Senate Budget Committee met on Friday, October 29, 2021 to deliberate and appropriate \$14,615,441 dollars in the annual budget of Activity and Service Fees for the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year, and,

Whereas: The Student Senate Budget Committee continued its zero-based budgeting process, where every organization starts with a base budget of \$0 for the next fiscal year and accrues funds as they are appropriated by the Committee, and,

Whereas: Within this appropriation, the Student Senate Budget Committee used its discretion to stipulate the total allotment in the OPS Wages category for each budgeted organization. In this appropriation, the Committee stipulates which positions are to be paid, their rate, and the amount of calendar weeks for their contract, as allowed by Florida Statutes, and,

Whereas: Under Student Body Statute 803.5 (A) it is stipulated that "Wages may only be drawn from this account in the manner explicitly stated by the Student Senate in the proviso language of the annual budget (or the Sweepings or Central Reserves proviso). Money may not be redistributed within the category except as stipulated in 803.5 B." and,

Whereas: Under Student Body Statute 803.5 (B) it is stipulated that "Changes in the manner in which an SGA-funded entity distributes its wages (i.e., creating or removing an OPS paid position, increasing or decreasing the hours/week of a current OPS paid position, or increasing/decreasing the hourly wage of an OPS paid position) must be approved by the Student Senate through resolution. This resolution must first be referred to, and passed by majority vote, the Senate Budget committee." and,

Whereas: The Student Senate Budget Committee added new OPS positions and both increased and decreased hours/weeks for various OPS positions, none of which are filled for the next fiscal year. In this appropriation, the Committee accounted for the \$11-dollar minimum wage increase, all of which is stipulated in the Budget Proviso Language and the accompanying chart. Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Seventy-Third Student Senate at Florida State

University that: The changes in OPS Wages, as stipulated by Budget Bill 2022, its Proviso Language, and the accompanying chart are done and ordered by the Seventy Third Student Senate and shall be sent to all budgeted organizations under Bill 2022. If any discrepancies exist or any further changes must be made, they shall first be sent to the Student Senate Budget Committee for approval via resolution, as stipulated by Student Body Statute 803.5 (B).
