A revision to the Student Body Statutes

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SEVENTY FOURTH STUDENT SENATE THAT:

A revision is made to the Student Body Statutes SBS §1005.4 (See attached).

To amend the statute to provide temporary relief to the Hispanic/Latinx Student Union by allowing them more time to appoint executive board members until such time that permanent statutory changes can be proposed by the SGA Commission empaneled by 74th Student Senate Resolution 5. Effectuating this bill would require that all executive board applications be closed by March 31, 2022, and would seek to avoid any delay in filling executive board positions for the 2022-2023 executive board transition. This bill is presented to the Student Senate following consultations with the Student Senate President, Parliamentarian, and HLSU Director.

PROVISO: This provisions in this bill shall cease to be in effect (sunset) on May 31, 2022.

1005.4 Executive Board

- A. Membership
The Executive Board shall consist of the Director, Assistant Director, Secretary, Treasurer, and Outreach Coordinator, Public Relations Coordinator, and Professional Development Coordinator.
- B. Qualifications
The qualifications are as follows:
 - 1. Students in good standing at FSU with a minimum 2.0 GPA
 - 2. Have an interest in promoting and contributing to the Hispanic/Latinx culture and community on campus
 - 3. Have held at least one leadership position at a college level.
- C. Selection and term of Office

Applications for all positions must be publicly released in the Spring semester. Completed applications must be received by the current Executive Board no later than midnight on the last business day in the month of March. Interviews will be set by the current Executive Board once all applications have been received.

1. Director and Assistant Director

The Director and Assistant Director shall be nominated with a majority (50 percent plus 1) vote by the previous Executive Board and appointed by the Student Body President. If a current Executive Board Member is running for a position on the following year's Board, that individual may not be present at any interviews for the position and shall not cast a vote.

2. Treasurer, Secretary, Outreach Coordinator, Public Relations Coordinator, and Professional Development Coordinator

The newly appointed Director and Assistant Director shall interview applicants and recommend nominees for Treasurer and Secretary to the Student Body President for Student Senate confirmation by the last Senate of the Spring semester. These new officers will officially take office upon confirmation by the Student Senate and serve for a full academic year thereafter. Those positions not requiring Student Senate confirmation shall be selected by the new Director after each applicant is interviewed and consultations with the new Assistant Director take place.
