## Chapter 700

### Restrictions on Amending and Enforcing the Election Code

- A. Once the date of an election has been determined, according to 705.4 and 706.5, the election code used for that election cannot be changed.
- ~~B.~~ The Election Code shall be enforced year round

## 711.4

### Reporting Procedures

- D. The Supervisor of Elections and the Deputy Supervisor(s) shall have the power to receive and review alleged violations pursuant to Chapter 702.4(D) of the Student Body Statutes. The time, place, and manner of such violations shall be recorded and submitted to the Elections Commission.
- E. All alleged violations and appeals must be presented to the Supervisor of Elections electronically by the end of two (2) business days from their discovery. The final deadline for all alleged violations and appeals to be filed by an individual or political party for a particular election, is forty-eight (48) consecutive hours after the close of polls of that election.
