A revision to the Student Body Statutes

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SEVENTY FOURTH STUDENT SENATE THAT:

A revision is made to the Student Body Statutes 400.2 E, 400.2 F, 403.2 (See attached).

To amend the statute to move the duties of the Senate newsletter from the Senate President to the Senate Press Secretary and Senate Historian. This will allow the Senate newsletter to be done more consistently as well as open more transparency of what the Student Senate does to our constituents in the Student Body.

- E. There shall be a Senate Historian, who shall be appointed by the Student Senate President, subject to confirmation by the Student Senate, from outside the members of the Senate and who shall serve at the Student Senate President's discretion. The Historian shall be responsible for taking Senate Chamber minutes. The Historian, along with the Senate Press Secretary, shall have the responsibility of publishing a Senate newsletter to document Senate legislative actions and updates along with the Senate Press Secretary. The Historian shall also perform any other duties that the Student Senate President or President Pro-Tempore shall determine to be necessary for these purposes;.

F. There shall be a Senate Press Secretary, who shall be appointed by the Student Senate President, subject to confirmation by the Student Senate_{7.} <u>The Senate Press Secretary shall be</u> from outside the members of the Senate and who shall serve at the Student Senate President's discretion. The Press Secretary shall be responsible for maintaining the Senate social media presence and outreach and create a weekly calendar of Student Senate funded or related events. The Press Secretary shall work with committee chairs to help inform the student body on committee meeting information. <u>The Press</u> <u>Secretary shall have the responsibility of publishing a Senate newsletter to document Senate</u> <u>legislative actions and updates along with the Senate Historian The Press Secretary, along with the</u> <u>Senate Historian, shall have the responsibility of publishing a Senate newsletter to document</u> <u>Senate legislative actions and updates</u>. The Press Secretary shall also perform any other duties that the Student Senate President or President Pro-Tempore shall determine to be necessary for these purposes.

1. The Senate Press Secretary Shall attend a training session with the SGA Webmaster to ensure that postings are within the Florida State University communications guidelines. This shall ensure that the social media properly represents the Student Senate.

- 403.2 A Senate newsletter may shall be published by the Student Senate to document Senate legislative actions and updates. It shall be the <u>collaborative</u> duty of the Student Senate President Press Secretary and Senate Historian to ensure the creation and publication of this newsletter- <u>under the supervision of the Senate President</u>. The Senate President may delegate this task to other Senators or Senate Officers.
 - <u>a.</u> <u>The Senate newsletter is to be published on the SGA website at minimum once a month.</u>
 - <u>b.</u> <u>The Senate newsletter will be printed into a physical copy for anyone at the first</u> <u>Senate meeting of every month.</u>
 - <u>c.</u> If the Senate newsletter is published more than once a month, the following edition or editions must be brought to a Senate meeting before the first Senate meeting of the following month.
