900.5 Termination Student Senate Oversight

- A. Bureaus shall be annually reviewed by the Internal Affairs Committee, which shall recommend to Student Senate if a Bureau shall continue to exist. provide recommendations to the bureaus as to how to improve their efficiency, and shall reserve the right to recommend the abolition of specific bureaus to the Student Senate and Executive Branch. The committee's recommendations shall be expressed in the form of individual resolutions for each bureau.
- B. Bureau Review shall be conducted each Spring semester and be completed by Spring Inauguration. The Internal Affairs Committee shall deliberate on and consider the following in its recommendations for each bureau:
 - i. Compliance with Student Body Statutes
 - ii. Executive Board composition and forwarding process
 - iii. Satisfaction with the bureau's financial allocations and its requests for future funding
 - iv. <u>The bureau's fulfillment of its mission statement and of tangible outcomes</u>
 - v. Effective execution of past and future programming
 - vi. Overall efficiency of the bureau's operations
