Resolution #: 53

Primary Sponsor: Schindler, Malone Co-Sponsor(s): Long

Whereas: The Office of Faculty Development and Advancement (FDA) oversees the Academic Honor Policy and is responsible for administering relevant violations and sanctions to members of the student body, and

Whereas: FDA presented potential changes to the policy to Student Senate in Spring 2022, and

Whereas: The Student Senate voted in favor of such changes, and

Whereas: Subsequently, the Board of Trustees also approved these changes, allowing FDA to implement such change, and

Whereas: A significant change to the policy allows for single-time offenders to have their records expunged through a new process, and

Whereas: Since implemented, FSU students may not been alerted to the changes in the Academic Honor Policy.

Be it resolved by the Seventy-fourth Student Senate at Florida State University that: We encourage the Office of Faculty Development and Advancement make the student body aware of all policy changes.

Be it further resolved that: The Student Senate and FDA should communicate with each other to educate the student body on academic integrity and the Academic Honor Policy, and
