Whereas: Per Student body Statutes 614.5, the Student Academic Programs (SAP) Funding Committee shall submit its allocations to the Student Senate Budget Committee, then the Budget Committee shall hear the allocations and draft a resolution to recommend approval or disapproval in whole or part, and

Whereas: The SAP Funding Committee was allocated a total of \$12,500 for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year, and

Whereas: The SAP funding committee heard requests from two (2) SAPs: World Affairs Program and Case Competition Club and allocated \$11,947 to the World Affairs Program and \$553 to the Case Competition Club, and

Whereas: The Budget Committee unanimously voted to approve the proposed allocations from the SAP Funding Committee, which are detailed in the line item chart below, therefore

Be it resolved by the Seventy-fourth Student Senate at Florida State University that: The funding allocated to the Student Academic Programs Funding Committee shall be allocated in the manner detailed below, with the stipulation that the Proviso Language is followed.

Resolution 2022
Student Academic Programs Funding Committee Proviso Language
Special Instructions

I. General

- A. Any funds not spent after to May 31, 2022, shall be returned to SGA.
- B. Physical equipment purchased with these funds shall be properly marked as paid for by SGA.
- C. No A&S are to fund events that involve fundraising for any individuals, organization, or department.
- D. All SGA monies allocated under this resolution shall be governed under Finance Code In Student Body Statutes Chapter 800, and shall be subject to all the provisions contained therein.
- E. Any and all organizations found in violation of Student Body Statutes shall be subject to the appropriate sanctions contained in the Finance Code and recommended by the Finance Committee, the Budget Committee, and the Student Senate.

II. World Affairs Program

- A. This organization shall be funded \$11,947 for the LAMUN, VICS, & MUN conferences.
- B. These conferences shall be open and advertised to the entire student body, per Student Body Statutes.

III. Case Competition Club

- A. This organization shall be funded \$145 for a Squarespace Website.
- B. This organization shall be funded \$150 for a Retractable Banner.
- C. This organization shall be funded \$40 for a Iceberg Fabric Table Cover.
- D. This organization shall be funded \$123 for Pens.
- E. This organization shall be funded \$65 for Laptop/Bottle Stickers.
- F. This organization shall be funded \$10 for Hammermill Paper.
- G. These resources shall be open to the entire student body, per Student Body Statutes.

IV. Severability Clause

- A. Any part, provision, or representation of this Bill which is prohibited, or which is held to be void or unenforceable shall be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability without invalidating the remaining provisions hereof. The Senate shall be informed during their next regular meeting if any person deems any part, provision, or representation of this Bill prohibited, void, or unenforceable at any time.
