74th STUDENT SENATE Senate Resolution

Resolution #: 47
Primary Sponsor: Rowan

Whereas: Resolution 5 of the 74th Student Senate established the Commission on Student Government to engage in a wholesale review of Student Government, and

Whereas: The Commission, and its committees have been hard at work analyzing the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial branches, our bureaus, agencies, and affiliated projects, the appointments process, the Election Code, and the Finance Code, and

Whereas: Due to issues with initial appointments and organization, the Commission did not get started on their work until approximately 2-3 months after it was convened, and


Whereas: Under the current leadership of the Commission and its committees, the Commission has been able to get a substantial amount of work done, and

Whereas: The initial deadline of the end of the Summer 2022 semester has proved to be too soon, therefore

Be it resolved by the Seventy-fourth Student Senate at Florida State University that: The Commission on Student Government, as established in Resolution 5, shall be extended until September 28th, 2022, and the Commission is advised that, due to deadlines surrounding constitutional amendments, recommendations need to be in by this time, and
