603.2 PCC Student Elections

A. Franchise

1. All students enrolled at PCC are eligible to vote in the semi-annual PCCSGC elections. Students enrolled at the main campus are ineligible to vote in the semi-annual PCC-SGC elections.
2. All students enrolled at PCC are eligible to vote in FSU-SGA Presidential, ~~and Vice Presidential, and Treasurer~~ elections and/or on Amendments to the Student Body Constitution, in the manner outlined by the FSU-SGA Supervisor of Elections in accordance with Chapter 700 of Student Body Statutes. ~~either by absentee ballot or by vote at a poll established at PCC by FSU-SGA. All sealed absentee ballots are to be delivered to the Commissioner of Elections by the day of voting at the Tallahassee campus.~~
