Statute/Amendment Text

- F. The standing Campus Recreation Board, given it has a majority of seats filled, shall choose replacements if a board member resigns or is suspended, at the discretion of the Board.
- F. In the case of a vacancy on the Campus Recreation Board, the Chair will publish the vacancy and application window, and hold one interest meeting, while the window is open. The application window must be open for ten (10) business days, and must be opened within one (1) business day of the Campus Recreation Board being notified of the vacancy.
 - 1. <u>The Campus Recreation Board shall conduct interviews with all those who</u> <u>applied. At least three (3) Campus Recreation Board members must be present</u> <u>during all interviews. Interviews must be conducted within five (5) business days</u> <u>of closing the application window.</u>
 - 2. <u>The Campus Recreation Board will then meet within seven (7) days and choose a</u> <u>new member at the discretion of the Board to be sworn in at their next meeting.</u>
