Whereas: Strozier Library is a foundational academic hub, serving as a beacon of knowledge and collaborative learning for the student body of Florida State University (FSU), and


Whereas: The third floor group study rooms (Room 331, 332, 333, 335, 336, 337, 341, 342) are pivotal spaces for students, providing environments conducive to collaboration and individual study, and

Whereas: The functionality and safety of the current electrical outlets in these rooms have deteriorated, causing difficulties for students when trying to securely connect electronic devices, and

Whereas: Ensuring proper and reliable electrical connections is essential for the academic success and overall well-being of FSU students, therefore

Be it resolved by the Seventy-fifth Student Senate at Florida State University that: A strong advocacy for the immediate renovation and upgrade of the electrical outlets in the aforementioned group study rooms is hereby established. It is recommended that each of the 8 rooms should be equipped with at least 2 new outlets, culminating in a total of 16 new outlets for the entire floor, and
