Whereas: There is an amendment that could be made to the Senate Rules of Procedure to update the document with current practices and selection of Liaisons, and

Whereas: Student Body Statute §401.1 states, "Changes to the Rules of Procedure must be done through resolution and adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Senate," therefore

Be it resolved by the Seventy-Sixth Student Senate at Florida State University that: Due to the continued use of more liaison positions, that are becoming increasingly required to be involved in the Student Senate's operations, as well as the need to ensure that consistent communication between the Student Senate and external entities, Rule 2.9.(d) of Student Senate Rules of Procedure be amended as follows:

- d. The Student Senate President shall, at minimum, assign a liaison to the Executive Branch, the Union Board, the Campus Recreation Board, the Congress of Graduate Students, the Class Councils, SGA Elections, SGA agencies, SGA Bureaus, <u>SGA Affiliated Projects, SGA-funded Student</u> <u>Leadership Councils</u>, the Childcare Center, Sustainable Campus, the Facilities <u>Department</u>, Transportation and Parking Services, the FSU Police Department, the Governing Greek Councils, the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life, and the FSU Food for Thought Pantry. They may also assign a liaison to any other on-campus entities, at their discretion.
 - 1. The Chair of the Budget Committee or Finance Committee shall liaise with the Student Body Treasurer's Office.
 - 2. The Student Senate President shall not assign a Senator to more than four (4) entities to liaise with.
