**THE SIXTY SEVENTH STUDENT SENATE**

- WHEREAS On Wednesday, February 4, 2015 HB 583 was filed in the Florida House by Representative Artiles, and
- WHEREAS HB 583 was referred to the House Civil Justice Subcommittee, the House Government Operations Subcommittee and the House Judiciary Committee, and
- WHEREAS HB 583 passed the House Civil Justice Subcommittee on March 4, 2015, and
- WHEREAS The Florida State University is committed to a policy of non-discrimination for any member of the University community on the basis of gender identity and gender expression, and
- WHEREAS The Student Government Association of Florida State University is dedicated to a policy which protects students from discrimination on the basis of gender identity and gender expression, and
- WHEREAS Gender identity is psychological and not biological, and
- WHEREAS Gender identity includes non-binary genders including but not limited to agender, genderqueer, two-spirit, genderfluid, neutrois and bigender, and
- WHEREAS HB 583 would deny transgender people access to public facilities that match their gender identity, and
- WHEREAS The Florida State University Student Government, in representing the Student Body stands in strong opposition to any and all propositions that would discriminate on the basis of gender identity, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY SEVENTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:**

The Florida State University Student Body vehemently opposes HB 583 and further urges the Florida Legislature to reject this bill.
