## **CHAPTER 207 The Student Government Training Act**

**History: Added by the 48th Senate Bill 165. Revised by the 52nd Senate Bill 66. Revised by the 54th Senate Bills 17 and 57. Revised by the 56<sup>th</sup> Senate Bills 70 and 109. Revised by the 62nd Senate Bill 102. Revised by the 66<sup>th</sup> Senate Bill .**

### 207.4 New Senator Orientation

A. The Student Senate President, in conjunction with Senate President Pro Tempore, or designated proxies, shall be required to conduct New Senator Orientation on the Wednesday and Thursday prior to the Fall and Spring Student Government Inaugurations. The seminar will be a training session to cover the Student Body Constitution and Statutes, the Senate Rules of Procedure, Robert Rules of Order, as well as any applicable parliamentary procedures.

B. It is the responsibility of the current or outgoing Senate President to conduct New Senator Orientation.

1. The Senate President has the option of delegating the responsibility of conducting New Senator Orientation to the Rules and Calendar Committee or a proxy of their choice

### 207.6 The New Senator Exam

A. The Rules and Calendar Committee shall be responsible for the creation of the New Senator Exam. The New Senator Exam should sufficiently test a senator's knowledge on the Student Body Constitution and Statutes, the Senate Rules of Procedure, Robert Rules of Order, as well as any applicable parliamentary procedures.

B. The Senate President and Senate Pro Tempore, or their proxies, are responsible for administering the exam to new senators.

1. The Senate President and Senate Pro Tempore may work with the Student Government Webmaster in order to administer the New Senator Exam online.
2. The New Senator Exam must be taken and passed within the first three (3) weeks of a senator's time in office.
3. The senator must pass the exam within three (3) attempts, with an 80 percentile correct.

C. If a senator does not complete the New Senator Exam with a passing grade within the specified time period they will be removed from office.
