Whereas: The Florida State University is an institution where all students should feel welcomed and safe, and

Whereas: Two of the tenants of The Seminole Creed are Respect and Diversity, and

Whereas: Hate speech creates an environment of hostility, prejudice, bigotry, and a fear of violence, and

Whereas: 1,835 students were asked if they agree with the statement “We the students of Florida State University acknowledge that hate speech targeting FSU students is not in line with the values of the Seminole Creed. Hate Speech should be clearly defined in the Student Conduct Code and penalties for using hate speech should be added to the Student Conduct Code” and 82.4% of the students asked agreed, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY-SIXTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

Hate speech should be clearly defined in the Student Conduct Code and penalties for using hate speech should be added to the Student Conduct Code.
