Resolution 13
Sponsored by: Senators Wood and Forst

Title: Resolution in Support of Tuition Equity for Undocumented Students

WHEREAS, in 2012, the Pew Research Center found that close to 1.4 million undocumented immigrants would benefit from the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program,

WHEREAS, the DACA program allows undocumented students to register with the federal government, allow them to obtain a work permit, and avoid deportation for two years as long as certain conditions are met,

WHEREAS, Florida allows undocumented students to obtain a driver's license, and enroll in institutions of higher education,

WHEREAS, undocumented immigrants would have to pay out of state tuition in order to attend Florida State University, a cost set at \$21,741, which is almost four times the cost of in-state tuition,

WHEREAS, this cost place significant financial strain on undocumented immigrants who currently attend Florida State University, and may discourage such students from applying to Florida State University,

WHEREAS, the vision of Florida State University states "*The Florida State University will be one of the world's premier institutions of higher education, devoted to transforming the lives of our students, shaping the future of our state and society, and offering programs of national and international distinction in a climate of inquiry, engagement, collegiality, diversity, and achievement.*"

WHEREAS, the mission of Florida State University states "*The university strives to instill the strength, skill, and character essential for lifelong learning, personal responsibility, and sustained achievement within a community that fosters free inquiry and embraces diversity.*"

WHEREAS, Florida State University has produced several undocumented graduates, at both the graduate and undergraduate levels,

WHEREAS, current undocumented students attending Florida State University may be forced to drop out due to the out-of-state tuition costs, therefore increasing our dropout rate,

WHEREAS, eighteen other states across the United States have current policies that allow undocumented immigrants to benefit from in-state tuition rates; including Texas, Oklahoma, and New Jersey,

WHEREAS, other state universities, including Florida International University, University of South Florida, and University of Florida, have state their support for support for a such a policy,

WHEREAS, Florida International University has already approved a measure that would allow undocumented students to apply for in-state tuition,

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Florida State University Student Senate supports any legal measure that would allow undocumented students to benefit from in-state tuition rates, including Florida Senate Bill 300 and Florida House Bill 275,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Florida State University Student Senate encourages Student Body President Rosalia Contreras to write a letter in support of such policy to the University President Dr. Eric Barron.
