- WHEREAS: Florida State University has maintained a relationship built on respect and mutual support with the Seminole Tribe of Florida for 67 years¹, and
- WHEREAS: Chief Howard Tommie of the Seminole Tribe was elected Chairman of the Tribal Council in 1971 and served in that role till the end of the decade², and
- WHEREAS: Tommie advocated and testified for federal policies in Congress³ that allowed the Seminole Tribe along with several other Native American Tribes across the country to gain significant economic and social independence⁴, and
- WHEREAS: Tommie was the first honorary Seminole Tribal member on the Florida State University Homecoming Steering Committee in 1975⁵, and
- WHEREAS: The tradition of Osceola and Renegade was initially approved and endorsed by Tommie who also had members of the Seminole tribe design authentic Seminole clothing for the rider⁶, and
- WHEREAS: Chief Tommie passed away Friday, March 17, 2017⁷, and

On behalf of its members, recognizes the contributions Chief Howard Tommie made for the Seminole Tribe of Florida throughout his life, appreciates Tommie's strong support for the relationship between Florida State University and the Seminole Tribe of Florida, and extends its sincerest condolences to his family.
