BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY SIXTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The 66<sup>th</sup> Student Senate at The Florida State University supports the Honors, Scholars, and Fellows house in organizing an academic involvement fair during the 2014-2015 academic year.

Resolution 37

Sponsored By: Senators Butler and Patel

**Whereas:** The Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU) and The Florida State University (FSU) has shared a joint engineering program since 1983, and

**Whereas:** The Florida Senate has passed legislation to allocate funding for FSU to explore the separation of the FAMU and FSU engineering program in the pursuit of FSU becoming a Top 25 public university, and

**Whereas:** A joint engineering program does not inherently prevent FSU from becoming a Top 25 public university, and

**Whereas:** FSU has established a plan to become a Top 25 public university which does not include the separation of the FAMU and FSU engineering program, and

**Whereas:** FSU shares the Tallahassee community with FAMU, and

**Whereas:** Members of the FAMU, FSU, and Tallahassee communities have voiced concerns that the separation of the joint engineering program would have an adverse affect on FAMU, and

**Whereas:** The FAMU and FSU engineering program operates under a \$10,900,000 joint budget with FSU contributing an additional \$5,000,000, and

**Whereas:** FAMU has released an impact statement indicating that if the joint engineering program was separated, FAMU would need \$100,000,000 to build a new building on their campus plus an additional \$15,000,000 a year to operate its own engineering program, therefore

**LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY-SIXTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:**

The joint FAMU and FSU engineering program should not be separated.
