Resolution 38

Sponsored by Senator Butler

Whereas: Senators do not have an allotted time to ask candidates for Senate President and Senate President Pro Tempore questions, and

Whereas: All other candidates for positions that require senate confirmation are asked questions by the Senate, and

Whereas: Having majority and minority opinions published on the SGA website will increase senate transparency, and

Whereas: Some people communicate more effectively through the written word, and

Whereas: A resolution is required to amend the Senate Rules and Procedures, therefore

LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY-SIXTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The Senate Rules and Procedures be amended as follows:

9.06 In the event that senate legislation which requires a simple majority vote (50% + 1) to pass, passes with less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote, the Senate President shall have the authority to appoint a willing senator, within 24 hours of the senate meeting, who voted in the majority to write the majority opinion and a willing senator who voted in the minority to write the minority opinion. Each opinion shall be published on the SGA website and shall not exceed five hundred words. No senator shall be assigned to write more than one opinion per senate meeting. All opinions must be written within two calendar days after being assigned.

WHEREAS: The WVFS, “The Voice of Florida State” also referred to as V89 is an affiliated project of the Florida State University (FSU) Student Government and College of Communication, and the Pride Student Union is one of the Florida State University (FSU) Student Government’s agency, and

WHEREAS: Both campus entities are seeking to host their annual off campus event “V89 Summer Throwdown V”,

WHEREAS: The off campus event shall take place at Pug Mahone’s Live on June 21st from 9pm-2am,

WHEREAS: The event shall be free for all FSU students 18 years and older and no funds shall be raised from the event itself typically hosting an attendance of more than 300 individuals,

WHEREAS: It is one of their three yearly events hosted to help promote WVFS and SGA as well as goodwill with the students and community,

WHEREAS: Senate is required to grant permission for event to be held off campus,

WHEREAS: This event will also spend over \$2000,

WHEREAS: Senate permission is necessary for the expenditure of budgeted monies in excess of \$2000,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY FOURTH STUDENT SENATE AT THE FORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The Sixty Sixth Student Senate at the Florida State University shall grant permission to WVFS also referred to as V89 and Pride Student Union to host their event off campus and to spend more than \$2000.
