We plan to arrive and check into the hotel on July 30, and check out of the hotel on the morning of August 3, resulting in a total of a four night stay at the hotel.

Our event was advertised through various Social Media outlets including Facebook and at our weekly campus meetings, and through our weekly email newsletters.

Purpose of Trip

The purpose of the trip is to not only represent ourselves as an organization but also our country, our state, as well as our university, the Florida State University, at the Every Nation World Conference. The Every Nation World Conference occurs every three years and when is held, takes place in various countries throughout the world. Every Nation World Conference guests come from about sixty countries and many different colleges and universities. Through various workshops and activities such as college nights, we will be able to represent our university while at the same time interacting with students from both near and abroad. We are very fortunate to not only have the Every Nation World Conference here in the United States, but also in Florida this year.

How attendees were chosen:

Students were not individually chosen, rather open invitations have been offered constantly throughout the past academic school year. This has been done through various means including social media outlets such as Facebook, at our weekly campus meetings, and through our weekly email newsletters which reach hundreds of students on campus.

Expenses: Because of rarity of this conference being so close to our university as well as the strong urge demonstrated by the students to attend the conference, students are and have been willing to pay many of the fees out of pocket. These fees include registration, 59 dollars per person, which each student has already paid (see

attachment), transportation to the conference including gas, as well as food during the conference.

We are only asking for assistance with the hotel cost for the duration of the conference as well as parking fees while at the conference.

Hotel Cost:

The hotel that we are staying at, Swan and Dolphin Hotel, which is also the location of the conference, will cost 170 dollars per night after the conference's discounted rate. After careful thought and deliberation we concluded that staying onsite at the conference would be cheaper and more cost efficient for our students for various reasons, one reason is because of the cost of gas to commute which would in turn add to the overall cost of staying off site.

Because we will have 8 people attending the conference, 4 women and 4 men, we will need 1 room for the ladies, consisting of 4 of the ladies in the room, and 1 room for the men, consisting of 4 men.

1 Ladies Room at \$170 for 4 nights = \$680 + 12.5% tax (\$85) = \$765

1 Guys Room at \$170 for 4 nights = \$680 + 12.5% tax (\$85) = \$765
