WHEREAS: A team comprised of the Surfrider Foundation, the Big Bend Group of the Sierra Club, and the Florida State University's Office of Campus Sustainability, is working on an initiative to ban single-use plastic bags from campus operations, including food services and other business; and

WHEREAS: Single-use plastic bags are harmful because they are not biodegradable, they are not easily recyclable, and they release toxic chemicals into our soils and waterways; and

WHEREAS: Plastic bags threaten land and marine animals through fatal ingestion or entanglement; and

WHEREAS: There are massive patches of garbage in the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans (e.g. the "Great Pacific Garbage Patch"), largely comprised of plastic that cannot breakdown; and

WHEREAS: Trillions of plastic bags are used each year, thus calling for a major reduction in use; and

WHEREAS: Efforts to improve beautification and responsible environmental stewardship are strong priorities on campus; and

WHEREAS: Other campuses, including Gator Dining Services at University of Florida and initiatives at Flagler College in conjunction with the City of St. Augustine, have already banned or enacted voluntary bans of single-use plastic bags; and

WHEREAS: Reusable bags are the smarter, more economical, and more responsible alternative to single-use plastic bags,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SIXTY-FIFTH STUDENT SENATE THAT: The student body of the Florida State University supports the efforts of the Surfrider Foundation and the Office of Campus Sustainability to ban the use of single-use plastic bags wherever feasible and reasonable on the Florida State University Campus and to pursue the use of intelligent reusable bag alternatives.
